Check your level of teaching experience with your Fellowship Champion and/or complete the Fellowship Category Tool 2023 Advance HE. 2. You must attend both mandatory sessions delivered by the CLT. These can be booked through the CLT Hub 3. Work with your Fellowship Champion to draft your fellowship application. 4. Receive feedback on your application (ideally from an HEA Fellow) and identify an Advocate(s). 5. Act on feedback and finalise your application, then pass to Advocate(s) to complete their Statement(s). 6. When your application is ready to submit, advise your Fellowship Champion. They will contact the CLT to register your intention to submit and advise the submission deadline you can submit to. The submission deadlines are detailed in the (Key Information section on Moodle), including the date of the associated Panel, where results are ratified. You will receive your results shortly after the Panel. 7. Work with your GTA Mentor / Fellowship Champion to draft your fellowship application. 5. Receive feedback on your application (ideally from an HEA Fellow) and identify an Advocate. 6. Act on feedback and finalise your application, then pass to Advocate to complete their Statement. 7. When your application is ready to submit, advise your GTA Mentor / Fellowship Champion.
